Whilst there is no obligation for parents/carers to contribute, if the school is unable to raise enough funds for an activity or visit then it will be cancelled.

We provide financial assistance for families with children in receipt of pupil premium funding for our Y4 and Y6 residential. The school will consider, on an individual basis, whether financial support can be provided to families, to cover costs of any other activities.

If financial issues are affecting your ability to pay for any activities, please speak to any member of staff you feel comfortable with.

Drinks in school

We ask that all children bring a water bottle to school with their name on each day. A polite reminder that we expect children to have water in their bottles due to a) problems with cleaning up spillages and b) healthy schools guidance.
