**Key Vocabulary**

immortality	The ability to live forever; eternal life.
glacier	A slowly moving mass or river of ice on mountains.
anthem	A rousing song identified with a particular group or cause.
hexed	To cast a spell on; bewitch.
conjure	To make something appear unexpectedly or seemingly from nowhere.
wielding	Hold and use a weapon or tool or something abstract (like a power).
loathing	A feeling of intense dislike or disgust; hatred.
tundra	Land this is vast, flat, treeless and snowy. The soil is always frozen.
brandished	To wave something (particularly a weapon) as a threat.

**Rationale (linked to previous knowledge, LL intent statement, CARE values)**
